

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, NAMING THE SOUTHERN-MOST LITTLE LEAGUE FIELD AT WEST OAKS PARK AS “ANGELS’ FIELD, IN MEMORY OF LACEY, PHILLIP AND CHRISTOPHER”; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2015, Lacey McCarty (DOB 06/13/2007), Phillip McCarty (DOB 06/30/2008), and Christopher Swist (DOB 10/08/2014) were forcibly taken from this earth. Their tiny souls were removed from the physical world and now reside in Heaven, and

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2015, the City was approached by Stanley Swist, the grandfather of these children that met an untimely death. Mr. Swist requested that one of the Fields at West Oaks Park, 1161 Lamplighter Drive NW, be named “Angels’ Field” in honor of them as the two older children were active in Palm Bay West Little League, and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2015, the Recreation Advisory Board voted unanimously to recommend City Council name one of the fields as “Angels’ Field, In Memory of Lacey, Phillip and Christopher”, and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department recommend that the southern-most Little League bear this name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and, by this reference, are hereby incorporated into and made an integral part of this resolution.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby formally names the southern-most Little League Field at West Oaks Park as *“Angels’ Field, In memory of Lacey, Phillip and Christopher”*.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the enactment date.
